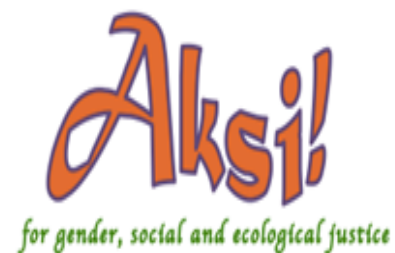


GENDER INTO URBAN CLIMATE CHANGE INITIATIVE (GUCCI)

Overall outcome & recommendations from the project



INSTITUTION LEVEL

- Government should nationalize and implement GAP with indicators at all levels
- A gender focal point at national, regional and local level
- Overcome the sectorized view of gender in urban climate policies
- Involvement of ministry of women empowerment, gender experts & women's organization

CAPACITY BUILDING

- Local councillors to be trained/empowered to deal with gender differentiated impacts
- Gender sensitization training for knowledge enhancement of officials/stakeholders
- Integrated Development Plan should be used as a tool to influence policy

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT / PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

- Regular and improvised stakeholder engagement and communication with the general public
- Enhance Women's organization and community leaders' involvement/participation
- Easy, transparent and approachable mechanism to connect with the government
- Establish a Gender sensitive & responsive complaint mechanism

PRINCIPLES

- ‘Root cause of vulnerability’ to be primary focus
- National policies should explicitly address care work and care economy and prevent generating extra burdens for women
- Indigenous and traditional knowledge need to be acknowledged
- Ensure women's human rights
- Develop climate actions that respect :
women's human rights
Mainstream gender &
Strengthen urban resilience

STRATEGIES

Urban policies should prioritize and focus on :

- * Effective public transport system with support to access various services
- * Upgrade city planning designs
- * Consider socio-economic & environmental architecture of cities
- * Train women professionally to enhance their capacity as first responders
- * Mapping of resources specifically with involvement of women/women's organization

APPROACHES, METHODS & DATA

- * Ensure equity and gender mainstreaming in policies at multi-level
- * Enhance knowledge and awareness about gender integration
- * Gender responsive budgeting at national as well as sub-national levels
- * Climate action review strategies should include risks, vulnerability and resilience capacity assessment
- * Sex and gender disaggregated data compilation

MULTI-LEVEL GOVERNANCE

National government to support sub-national and local government on gender integration

Supplementary climate action plans for bigger cities

Inter-institutional articulation and coordination among government departments

Effective involvement of researchers/academics, practitioners for appropriately mainstreaming gender
